SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES May 26, 2022

ATTENDANCE

Present: Mayor Ricky Waring, Councilmembers Aaron Brown, Russ Touchberry, Kima Garten-Schmidt and Terry Jenkins. Councilmember Bill McIntosh was absent for open session, but was on a conference call for Executive Session. Councilmember Bob Jackson was absent. Also in attendance were Town Administrator Lisa Wallace, Town Attorney GW Parker, and Town Clerk Beth Messervy. A quorum was met. Public and press were duly notified. The meeting took place in Council Chambers at 200 South Main Street, Summerville, SC 29483.

MEMORADUM OF UNDERSTANDING
