SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
August 30, 2019

ATTENDANCE

Present: Mayor Wiley Johnson, Councilmembers Christine Czarnik, Aaron Brown, Kima Garten-Schmidt, Walter Bailey, Bob Jackson and Bill McIntosh. A quorum was present. Staff was also present. Public and press were duly notified.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Wiley Johnson called the Special Council Meeting to order at 3:00pm on Friday, August 30, 2019.

REASSESSMENT PROCESS

Town Administrator Colin Martin gave a brief introduction, and Finance Director Andrew Shelton gave an overview of the reassessment process. He explained the Counties' calculation of rollback millage. He reported that the final rollback millage was calculated to be 60.2; staff's recommended millage for 2020 is 62.1 to account for an increase in growth.

Mr. Shelton answered questions from Council. Mr. Martin proposed that a budget retreat be held on September 20, 2019.

DISCUSSION OF MILLAGE

There was discussion on whether or not the Town should switch to a fiscal year budget instead of the calendar year budget that they have been operating on so as to make the millage and budgeting process easier.

Mr. McIntosh made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bailey, to set millage at 59.5. Some discussion followed regarding increases and decreases of millage revenue from previous years. The motion carried 5-2 with Ms. Czarnik and Mr. Brown voting in opposition.


